STATEMENT OF FAITH

I Believe:

- 1. The Holy Bible was written by men divinely inspired and is the record of God's revelation of Himself to man. It is a perfect treasure of divine instruction. It has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth, without any mixture of error, for its matter.
- 2. There is one and only one living and true God. He is an intelligent, spiritual, and personal Being, the Creator, Redeemer, Preserver, and Ruler of the universe. God is infinite in holiness and all other perfections. To Him we owe the highest love, reverence, and obedience. The eternal God reveals Himself to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being.
- 3. Christ is the eternal Son of God. In His incarnation as Jesus Christ he was conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He shed His Blood on the Cross and made provision for the redemption of men from sin. He raised from the dead with a glorified body and is now exalted at the right hand of God.

- II. ARTICLES OF FAITH—The Articles of Faith shall be The Baptist Faith and Message adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention, as amended. The Church does not condone or recognize any alternative definition of marriage, nor permit staff members to perform such ceremonies, nor allow the use of Church property or resources for such ceremonies (Genesis 2:18-24, Hebrews 13:4)
- III. We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to only occur between a man and a woman who are married to each other. On the authority of Scripture we believe any form of sexual immorality, such as adultery, fornication, homosexual or bisexual conduct, polygamy, pedophilia, bestiality, incest, pornography, or attempts to change one's biological sex, to be sinful and offensive to God (1Corinthians 5:1-5, 1 Corinthians 6:18-20).
- IV. CHURCH COVENANT —Our charter members established Bell Shoals Baptist Church in 1961. Having been led, as we believe, by the Spirit of God to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Savior, and on the profession of our faith having been baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, we do now in the presence of God and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another as one body in Christ:

TO commit ourselves as members to honor, esteem, and love our staff and one another;

TO pray for each other constantly and to manifest tender regard for our reputation;

TO walk together in Christian love by the aid of the Holy Spirit; to strive for the advancement of this Church and its ministries; to promote its prosperity and spirituality; to sustain its worship, ordinances, discipline and doctrines;

TO contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the Church, the relief of those in need, and the spread of the gospel throughout all nations;

TO encourage family and private devotion; to maintain and support the family in the belief that biblical marriage is between one man and one woman; to educate our children religiously; to seek the salvation of our relatives, friends, neighbors and associates;

TO walk worthy of our calling in the world; to be just in our dealings, faithful to engagements and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid malicious use of the tongue; to keep our testimonies above reproach; and to be zealous in our efforts to advance the kingdom of our Savior;

TO watch over one another in brotherly love; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feelings and Christian courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense but always ready for

reconciliation and, mindful of scriptural guidelines, to secure it without delay; and

TO pledge that when we remove from this place, we will unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.
